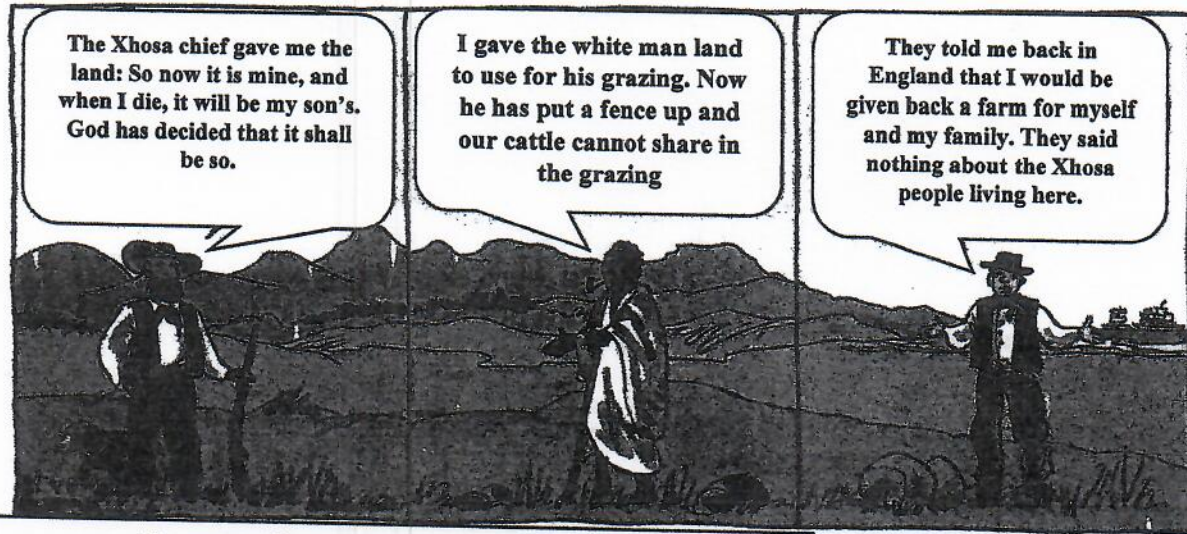


Figure A: Different groups in the Eastern Cape
