

After WW1 ended, the rate of inflation in the Weimar republic rose. The American government lent Germany money and the Weimar republic was stabilised for a while.



  3.2. On what object are the two people sitting on in the cartoon?


  3.3. Describe how the cartoonist is illustrating conflict between the two superpowers, USA and USSR, in the cartoon.


