## INSTRUCTION TO MARKERS

1) Candidates are required to answer ALL the questions.
2) This memorandum serves as a guide to markers. Some responses may require a marker's discretion.
3) Candidates' responses should be assessed as objectively as possible.

## MARKING THE COMPREHENSION

- Because the focus is on understanding, incorrect spelling and language errors in responses should not be penalized unless such errors change the meaning/understanding. (Errors must still be indicated.)
- If a candidate uses words from a language other than the one being examined, disregard those words, and if the answers still make sense, do not penalize. However, if a word from another language is used in a text and required in an answer, this will be acceptable.
- For open-ended questions, no marks should be awarded for YES/NO or I AGREE/I DISAGREE. The reason/substantiation/motivation is what should be considered.
- When one-word answers are required and the candidate gives a whole sentence, mark correct provided that the correct word is underlined/highlighted.
- When two/three facts/points are required and a range is given, mark only the first two/three.
- Accept dialectical variations.
- For multiple-choice questions, accept BOTH the letter corresponding with the correct answer AND/OR the answer written out in full.

1.7.3 The jogger does not understand how the lady's small effort could make a difference as she is saving only a few turtles. The elderly lady feels that she is making a difference in the world the turtles are living is, thus contributing to saving the world at large. $\checkmark \checkmark \checkmark$
1.8.1 You can change the world by performing good deeds./

Good deeds can make a difference to change the world. $\checkmark \checkmark$
NOTE: Accept other relevant summaries.
Allocate marks as follow:
ONE mark if the moral of the story was correctly summarized.
ONE mark if the learner stick to the word count in the instruction.
1.9 NOTE:This is an open-ended answer. Accept a suitable response, provided it is grounded in TEXT A. A candidate can score ONE mark for an answer not well substantiated.
1.10 By biting/ eating something, you are actually destroying it. The headline suggests that you can save the planet by eating it. $\checkmark \checkmark$
1.11 He has a PH.D degree, suggesting that he is an expert.

He is described as a best-selling author. $\checkmark$
He is described as an award-winning documentarian. $\checkmark$
NOTE: Accept any TWO of the above.
1.12 Yes

If you are a vegan and do not eat animals or animal products, you will contribute to saving certain species. / You will prevent cruelty to animals that are killed for their meat or bred for their products like milk and eggs. $\checkmark \checkmark$

## OR

No
Certain animals are bred for consumption or for the use of their products and by consuming it, it will not make any difference to the survival of the earth. $\checkmark \checkmark$

NOTE: This is an open-ended answer. Accept a suitable response, provided it is grounded in TEXT B. A candidate can score ONE mark for an answer not well substantiated.

## QUESTION 2

The following points form the answer to the question:

| QUOTATIONS | FACTS |

| 1 "Use cash for non-bill spending ..." | 1 Use cash to prevent you from overspending. |
| 2 "Put your cash in envelopes each month and mark them clearly for their purposes." | 2 Allocate money to cover specific expenses to prevent you from spending it on unplanned purchases. |
| 3 "... start by putting R50-R100 away every week." | 3 Save small amounts of money on a weekly basis. |

## MARKING THE SUMMARY

Marking is on the basis of the inclusion of valid material and the exclusion of invalid material.

The summary should be marked as follows:

* Mark allocation:
- 7 marks for 7 points (1 mark per main point).
- 3 marks for language.
- Total marks: 10
* Distribution of language marks when candidate has not quoted verbatim:
- 1-3 points correct: award 1 mark
- 4-5 points correct: award 2 marks
- 6-7 points correct: award 3 marks
* Distribution of language marks when candidate has quoted verbatim:
- 6-7 quotes: award no language mark
- 1-5 quotes: award 1 language mark
* Word count:
- Markers are required to verify the number of words used.
- Do not deduct any marks if the candidate fails to indicate the number of words used, or if the number of words used is indicated incorrectly.
- If the word limit is exceeded, read up to the last sentence above the stipulated upper limit and ignore the rest of the summary.
