QUESTION 5

- 5.1 To decorate the garment. (2)
- 5.2
 - Cuffs must have crisp, sharp edges.
 - Cuffs must be of even width.
 - Cuffs with no opening must be large enough for the hand to slip through.
 - Cuffs with an opening must fit snugly around the wrist.
 - Most cuffs must be interfaced.
 - Choose the correct fasteners for the type of cuff used.
 - Use the correct sleeve placket with the type of cuff used. (Any 4 × 2) (8)
- 5.3 Bound buttonhole (1)
- 5.4
 - Bound edges must be of the same thickness.
 - All the buttonholes must be of the same length.
 - The size of the rectangles must be straight with no corner damage. (3 × 2) (6)

 - 5.5.1
 - Covers the interior construction.
 - Allows for the garment to slide on and off easily.
 - 5.5.2
 - It provides neatness✓ and warmth.✓
 - 5.5.3
 - Gives support and body to the garment fabric.
 - It hides the inner construction.
 - It inhibits stretching, acts as a buffer layer to catch hems and other inner fabrics. (Any 2 × 1)
