- 4.1 A sleeve with a very wide lowered armhole
- 4.2 A type of yoke that fits across the top of the back and over the shoulders
- 4.3 Self-enclosed seam in which all seam allowances are contained within the finished seam
- 4.4 A fabric tunnel made to enclose the elastic
- 4.5 Cutting of seam allowances in different widths
- 4.6 Slits cut into the seam allowances of a convex curve
- 4.7 Two folds of each pleat are turned away from one another
- 4.8 The seam is used to eliminate the bulk in the garment
- 4.9 The pocket which is visible on the outside of the garment
- 4.10 The shaped facing in which both the neck and armholes are finished by the same facing unit

**SECTION B****QUESTION 5**

- 5.1
- Fuse the interfacing
  - With the right sides together, stitch one side of the band against the garment
  - Grade the seam
  - Fold the waistband to the inside to cover the seam and slipstitch
  - Press the seamline

- They must be evenly and accurately spaced
  - They must be of even width from fold to fold
  - They must lie flat
  - They must be stitched in straight, parallel lines
  - Stitching quality must be correct
