QUESTION 5

- Fuse the interfacing
 - With the right sides together, stitch one side of the band against the garment
 - Grade the seam
 - Fold the waistband to the inside to cover the seam and slipstitch
 - Press the seamline (5 × 2)
- 5.2 They must be evenly and accurately spaced
 - They must be of even width from fold to fold
 - They must lie flat
 - They must be stitched in straight, parallel lines
 - Stitching quality must be correct (5 × 2)

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
