- 2 Study the ingredients below of how to make fat cakes and answer the questions

**INGREDIENTS MAKES 10
FAT CAKES**

- ☐ 25,2 ounces of flour
- ☐ $1\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons salt
- ☐ 2 tablespoon sugar
- ☐ 1 packet yeast
- ☐ Lukewarm water
- ☐ Cooking oil (for frying)

**NOTE:**

1 cup of flour = 4.2 ounces

1 cup = 250 ml

1 tablespoon = 15 ml

- 2.1 2.1.1 How many ml of sugar will be needed to make 10 fat cakes? (2)
- 2.1.2 In the cooking instructions, it indicates that the oil must be heated to 375 °F before frying the fat cakes. Convert 375 °F to °C. Round off your answer to the nearest ten degrees Celsius.
- The following formula may be used:
 $^{\circ}\text{F} = 1.8 \times ^{\circ}\text{C} + 32$ (4)

- 2.2 Mr. Kobe is an athletics teacher at Melody High School. To prepare for the school's regional athletics competition, he encourages the athletes to run every Saturday morning. He keeps the record of their starting time and finishing time in table below.

TABLE 1: Record of starting and finishing time for each runner

Runner	Zoey	Siyanda	Leroy	Princess	Chris	Nhlanhla
Starting time	10:00	10:00	10:00	10:00	10:00	10:00
Finishing time	11:51	10:59	11:16	11:44	11:22	11:05

Use the table above to answer the questions that follow:

- 2.2.1 How many athletes are trained by Mr. Kobe? (2)
- 2.2.2 Write the finishing time for Chris in a 24-hour format. (2)
- 2.3 Ayanda and his friends plan a tour across South Africa. The tour is set to stretch from Port Elizabeth down the Garden route to Cape Town. They investigated the rates for Shlobo Car hire and eNIGMA Car Rental. The distance from Port Elizabeth to George is 335km and from George to Cape Town is 434km.

The table below gives the cost for the two rental options.

COMPANY/DISTANCE (In km)	0	50	100	B	1000	2000
SHLOBO CAR HIRE	A	175	375	1400	3500	7000
ENIGMA CAR HIRE	0	2000	2000	2075	2975	4475

NOTE

Enigma car hire: Cost = R2000 + R1,50 × (distance – 350 km)

Shlobo car hire: Cost = R3,50 × distance

- 2.3.3 Use the formula provided to show by calculation which option would be the best rental for the boys to tour with? (5)

QUESTION 3

3.1

Miss Mendes lives in Ridgeview Estate and has a circular swimming pool with dimensions as shown below. The pool is situated at the back of the yard. She wants to put a circular fence around it. The fence will be 2 meters from the pool.



The radius of the pool is 150 inches

NOTE:

$$1 \text{ m}^3 = 1000 \text{ } \ell$$

$$1 \text{ inch} = 2,54 \text{ cm}$$

You may use the following formulae:

- **Volume cylinder** = $\pi r^2 h$
- **Area of a circular pool** = $\pi \times (\text{radius})^2$
- **Circumference of the fence** = $2 \times \pi \times \text{radius}$
- **Surface area of an open cylinder** = $\pi \times \text{radius} \times (\text{radius} + 2 \times \text{depth})$
- **Where $\pi = 3,142$**

NOTE:

Tiles = 0,2 m × 0,2 m (16 in a box)

- 3.1.1 Define the term radius according to the context. (2)
- 3.1.2 Convert the radius of the pool to meters. (3)
- 3.1.3 Calculate to the nearest thousand square inches the area of the swimming pool. (3)

- 3.1.4 The capacity of the pool is 35 000 liters. Calculate to the nearest meter the depth of the pool (7)
- 3.1.5 To clean the pool, she uses HTH chlorine powder. HTH is sold in 8kg buckets. She uses 128g of chemicals per 10 000 liters of water per day.
- 3.1.6 Verify, showing all calculations, whether the 8kg bucket in March will be enough for cleaning the pool. (5)
- The total inner surface of the cylindrical pool will be tiled. The tiler states that he requires more than 1 738 tiles to complete the tiling. Verify, showing ALL calculations, whether his statement is valid (7)
